**Under this agreement for 2017
Milpera State High School will receive**

\$380,985*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a band-scale three at exit from 85% to 90%, averaged across the skills of reading, writing, speaking and listening.
- Provide access to the Number Intervention and Mathematics Support Programs for identified students to provide the opportunity to master the four Mathematical operations by the time of exit from Milpera State High School.
- Enhance teachers' pedagogical practices and ability to engage students through a process of coaching and mentoring.

Our initiatives include

- Building teacher capacity to identify and use high yield strategies for feedback for second language acquisition and engagement for EAL/D students.
- Workplace reforms to enhance curriculum leadership through the continuation of two 0.5 Head of Department positions (Science and Mathematics).
- Targeted intervention strategies for students needing additional support in English language literacy and numeracy and those with disabilities through increased teacher and teacher-aide support.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Maintaining the 0.5 Science and Mathematics Head of Department positions. \$45 000
- Employing 1.9 teachers to enable curriculum development, professional development and the improvement of teaching pedagogies through coaching and mentoring. \$205 000
- Employing 0.5 Mathematics teachers for intervention strategies. \$53 500
- Employing additional teacher aides to support intervention programs for literacy and numeracy and the education of students with disabilities. \$45 985
- Partially funding therapy services through the school's HEAL centre to ensure students' readiness to learn. \$31 500
